

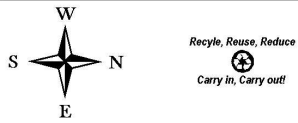
**Rules and Regulations**

Rules are necessary to preserve the parks appearance and to prevent any major mishaps. Please make your visit safe and enjoyable by following posted rules and regulations.

- In case of emergency, or to contact a park ranger dial 911
- Park in designated parking lots only.
- Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited.
- The park is closed from dusk to dawn. The front gate is open at 8:00 A.M.
- Visitors must clean up after their pets.
- Wildlife and plant life shall be left undisturbed.
- Additional information is posted on the bulletin boards.

From Route 30, Follow Sherman Street north for approx. 3 miles to Mundis Race Rd. Turn Left  
Park is 1/2 mile on the right.
